PURPOSE OF THE ROLE

Pilgrims Hospices are working in partnership with 'Tools for Self Reliance - Canterbury', which is a local group of the UK based charity working to help relieve poverty in Africa. A key part of their mission is to collect and refurbish used, good quality hand-tools, to be sent to developing countries to empower people and help rural communities to build sustainable livelihoods.

The main purpose of the role is to work within the group, to restore tools to a safe and fit-for-purpose condition, capable of giving many years of regular use.

KEY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

May include, but are not limited to:

- Assessing and sorting incoming tools
- Preparing unsuitable items for recycling
- Cleaning, sharpening, repairing and painting tools, in accordance with guidance material
- Leaving the workshop area clean at the end of each session
- At all times, working within the agreed health and safety guidance

PURPOSE OF THE ROLE

Volunteer Gardeners will work with the Head Gardener in Canterbury to support the care of the gardens and grounds of the Hospice and maintain them to an excellent standard.

- Undertaking general gardening tasks including mowing grass, planting, pruning, weeding, watering, mulching, cutting back, potting etc., whilst keeping disruption to a minimum
- Maintaining the site, including the Labyrinth, shrub borders, lawns, hedges, tree management, pots, hanging baskets and containers, greenhouse and plant nursery
- Helping to keep the grounds clean and tidy and dispose of litter

PURPOSE OF THE ROLE

It is very important to Pilgrims Hospices that our buildings are in excellent condition, in order to ensure that our patient and visitors experience the best possible environment.

We have a dedicated team of Maintenance Engineers and the Volunteer Maintenance Assistant will support them to carry out important general maintenance duties across the grounds and buildings of the Hospices. In particular, undertaking general painting and decorating of rooms and communal areas.

- Undertaking general ad hoc maintenance and repair duties
- Assisting with painting and decorating
- Helping with moving and handling of equipment and furniture
