The Ann Robertson Centre is a conference, education and training centre which can be hired for a full range of events, product launches, away days and staff training. It is owned and operated by Pilgrims Hospices and adjoins the charity's Canterbury hospice in London Road.

Named after Ann Robertson, the founder of Pilgrims Hospices, all profits from the centre will go towards the running costs of the hospices at Canterbury, Ashford and Thanet.

Pilgrims Hospices provides free care to patients with life-limiting illness across east Kent.

The Geoffrey Chaucer room (ground floor) and William Harvey room (first floor)

These rooms can seat 12 people in boardroom style or up to 20 in theatre style. Each room is equipped with a large flatscreen TV with laptop and projector connections. These rooms have air conditioning facilities. The Geoffrey Chaucer room has the additional benefit of a hearing loop.

The largest room can seat 30 people in theatre style or 15 in classroom or boardroom styles. It has a large flat screen TV, hearing loop, laptop and projector connections. This room has air conditioning facilities.

Clinical room

Clinical/Boardroom (first floor)

A clinical room with sink is available for events which call for hands on demonstrations and practical working. The room comes complete with TV and laptop for presentations. This room seats 10 people.

Conservatory

For a more informal meeting the conservatory is ideal, with views looking out to our gardens and a choice of soft seating as well as tables and chairs, for up to 14 people.

Reception

There is a welcome area and a conservatory for guests to enjoy refreshments.

Wheelchair access

The Ann Robertson Centre's facilities

are fully compliant with the regulations of the Equality Act 2010 including easy access around the building for wheelchairs and a lift to the first floor.

Internet connection

There is free Wifi access throughout the centre.

Parking and trains

The Ann Robertson Centre is in walking distance from the city centre and easily accessible from main roads, including the A2, and motorways. The centre offers 25 parking spaces for the use of delegates and there is free on street parking nearby. It is located three quarters of a mile from Canterbury West station and one and a quarter miles from Canterbury East station.
