Date

Sunday 4th December 2022

Time

The fun run will begin at 11:00 and **registration will open at 9:30**

Venue

Santas on the Harbour! will be starting and finishing at [Folkestone Harbour Arm, Folkestone CT20 1QQ](#).

Getting to Santas on the Harbour!

Santas on the Harbour! is taking place at a central location in Folkestone on the Harbour Arm so that it is accessible to all. If you can, please do walk to the venue or aim to be dropped off locally. There is on-street parking located close to the event as well a range of pay and display car parks. There is plenty of car parking available in the **Harbour Arm Car Park**, Harbour Approach Road, Folkestone CT20 1QH. However, please be aware of seasonal parking tariffs that do apply.

If you are travelling via public transport, there are multiple bus stops within Folkestone town centre which are a short walk away from our venue. Alternatively, Folkestone Central train station is a 25 minute walk from the venue.

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Event Check-In

Registration will open at **9:30** and will be located within Folkestone Harbour Train Station on the Folkestone Harbour Arm.

When you arrive, please head straight to our registration area where our volunteer elves will check you into the event. **You will be given a runner wristband which will correspond to our records, including your emergency contact information for the day**, you provided these at the point of registering online. If your emergency contact has changed, please let the registration volunteers know.

For the safety of everyone at the event, **it is essential that you check-in with our volunteers before taking part in the fun run.**

If you didn't collect your festive suit in advance at our collection evenings, you will be able to collect your festive suit at registration. Please note: Elf suits sold out in mid-November, therefore we are unable to change your suit choice on the day or at our collection evenings; to ensure everyone gets their booked choice of suit. Once collected, please find an open space away from the registration desks to get suited and booted for your fun run.

Please **register by 10:40** so that you can take part in our warm up.

If you are taking part in our tri-series, you will need to get your Christmas card stamped at the registration desk to receive your special tri-series medal at the end of the 3 festive fun runs in Margate!

Entering on the day

On the day registration will open at **9:30** within the registration area at the Folkestone Harbour Arm.

When you arrive, please head straight over to our on the day registration area where our volunteer elves will register you for the event and take payment.

Prices:

- Adult - £20
- Under 18 - £10
- Family ticket isn't available on the day

Entry includes a 5-piece Santa suit (ONLY) which you can pick up when you register on the day. Santa suits will be available on a first come, first served basis and therefore cannot guarantee Santa suits for those registering on the day. Please note: Elf suits sold out in mid-November.

Festive Suits

You will receive a suit as part of your registration and they will be given to everyone who has pre-registered. Our Santa and Elf suits come in adult size or child size, we can't guarantee that the fit will be perfect for you; but that's all part of the fun!

Our festive suit collection evenings will help you turn up to Santas on the Harbour! ready and raring to go.

We will be hosting two suit collections:

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- **Date: Tuesday 29 and Wednesday 30 November 2022**
- **Time: 16:00 - 18:30**

We kindly ask that you attend the festive suit collection for the Santas on the Run! event that you are registered for. Those registered for the tri-series can collect all three of their festive suits from any of the three collection venues.

Being as environmentally conscious as possible, we would ask that you try and keep your festive suits in as best condition as you can when running; it's a challenge in itself. Perhaps consider reusing them over the festive season. Please do not drop parts of the suit on the route and if you don't wish to reuse them; please drop them in our suit-drop areas; where the charity will be able to rag them and raise further funds from them via the charity retail team. Every penny helps!

Route

You have the choice of running a 3k or 5k route along the Folkestone Leas. All runners will dash through the Lower Leas Coastal Park. While the 3k runners circle back to Folkestone Harbour through the Lower Leas Coastal Park, the 5k Santas will continue through the park and return to Folkestone Harbour along Folkestone promenade, alongside beach views.

If you're running the 3k route, we advise that you stay to the left-hand side of the path within the Lower Leas Coastal Park on the lead up to the turn-around point.

Our MC and host is the wonderful, Kevin Daly, who will keep you entertained and will gather all of our runners ready for the warm-up. Shortly after, Pilgrims representatives will guide all participants to the start line at the Harbour Arm entrance. Please join the starting line in the following order:

- 5k runners
- 3k runners
- 5k walkers
- 3k walkers
- Any wheelchairs, buggies or wonderfully decorated festive sleighs, please join at the back.

We ask that you follow these instructions as they are for your safety.

Please keep in mind that this is a fun run and not a race of any type. If you would like to record your time please feel free to use a personal device to do so.

The route will be fully marshalled by volunteers in hi-vis vests. Please adhere to the instructions given to you by marshals and please be considerate to other path users as we are using shared paths on sections of the route.

In order for all of our Santas to have a safe and enjoyable event, dogs will not be able to attend Santas on the Run! Thank you for your understanding.

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First Aid

We will have first aid on the day provided by Black Ark Medical Services. If there is a medical emergency, you must call 999 and seek the help of the emergency services who are aware that the event is taking place. You should also tell your closest marshal so that they can contact the events team leader or call the event hotline number **07535 631568** so that our event medics can be mobilised as often they can arrive on scene faster than an ambulance.

Toilets

Toilets are available at the Harbour Arm along with a disabled public toilet. Public toilets will also be available within the Coastal Park at the 3k route split.

Changing Facilities and Valuables

There will be no changing facilities on the day. If you are collecting your suit at the venue, please wear an outfit to keep you warm that you can put your suit on over. There will not be a manned baggage area, therefore we advise you to only bring what you need and keep your belongings on you at all times.

Medals

You will receive a well-deserved finisher's medal when you return from your 3k or 5k run! When collecting your medal at the finish line, please continue moving forwards to avoid congestion.

Refreshments

We strongly encourage you to **bring your own filled water bottle with you** to ensure that you stay hydrated throughout your fun run and to support us in minimising the plastic used at our events. Large water barrels will be available at the start and finish to fill up water bottles.

Photography

We will have photographers at the event who will be taking photos and videos throughout to capture memories of the day. We'd love for you to pose for pictures and tell us your story of why you're taking part in Santa on the Run! However, please tell our team if you'd prefer not to have your photo taken.
