Date

Sunday 5th October 2025

Time

The fun run will begin at 11:30am and registration will open at 9am

Venue Location

Thanet 5k Colour Run will be starting at Palm Bay Green, Palm Bay Avenue, Cliftonville, Margate CT9 3NR

Getting to the event

The Thanet 5k Colour Run is taking place at Palm Bay Green, Palm Bay Avenue, Cliftonville, Margate, so that it is accessible to all. There is on-street parking located close to the event venue as well as a range of pay and display car parks, the closest one being Harold Road, Cliftonville Car Park (CT9 2HS).

If you are travelling via public transport, there are multiple bus stops a short walk from our venue, or Margate train station is a 30 minute walk from the venue.

Accessing Thanet 5K Colour Run

When you arrive at Palm Green, Cliftonville, Margate, you will see our event set up on the grassed area. Our volunteers will direct you to our registration desks where you can sign-in and collect your event kit: wristband, white t-shirt, sunglasses, and your powdered colour sachet. Additional colour sachets will also be on sale on the day for £2 each or 3 for £5. Please bring cash with you if you would like to purchase extra sachets.

Registration

Registration will open at **9am** and will be in alphabetical order by surname. Please register by **11**am so that you can take part in our dance warm-up!

White T-shirt, Sunglasses, Numbered Wristband and Powder Colour Sachet

Included with your advanced entry, you will receive the above items to wear at the event. These will be given to you on the day. You will receive your wristband participant number at the registration desk. Your number will be

assigned to you as an individual and correspond to the emergency contact information that you provided to us when registering online for the event. Please wear the number during the event so it is easily accessible on your wrist in case of an emergency.

Route

This is a circular 5k route along Cliftonville seafront, so where you start is where you finish. Colour stations are located at regular intervals, manned by event volunteers, who will make sure you finish as a multi-coloured masterpiece.

After the warm-up, we will ask for all of our runners, joggers and walkers to gather at the starting line in the following order:

- 5k runners
- 5K joggers
- 5k walkers
- Wheelchairs

We ask that you follow these instructions, as they are for your safety.

Please keep in mind that this is a fun run and **not a race** of any type. If you would like to record your time, please feel free to use a personal device to do so.

The route will be fully marshalled by volunteers in hi-vis vests. Please adhere to the instructions given to you by marshals, and please be considerate to other path users, as we are using shared paths.

In order for all of our runners, joggers and walkers to have a safe and enjoyable event, <u>dogs will not</u> be able to attend this event. Thank you for your understanding.

First Aid

We will have first aid on the day provided by Margate Ambulance. If there is a medical emergency, you must call 999 and seek the advice of the emergency services, who are aware that the event is taking place. You should also tell your closest marshal so that they can contact the events team leader or call the event hotline number **07738 851355** so that our event medics can be mobilised to the scene.

Toilets

Portaloos will be available at the start/finish area of the event. They are located at Palm Bay Green.

Changing Facilities and Valuables

There will be no changing facilities on the day.

There will not be a manned baggage area on the day, therefore we advise you to only bring what you need for the run and keep your belongings on you at all times.

Medals

You will receive a well-deserved finisher's medal when you return from your 5k run. Wear it with pride, share your photos and tell everyone what you did to support the charity as well as having an enjoyable and colourful time.

Refreshments

Bottled water will be available at the finish line. If you would like water whilst out on the route, we advise that you bring this with you on the day. There will also be an external catering vehicle supporting the event, which will accept cash or card payments.

Photography

We will have photographers at the event who will be taking photos and videos throughout to capture memories of the day. We'd love for you to pose for pictures and tell us your story of why you're taking part in our Colour Run. However, please tell our team if you'd prefer not to have your photo taken.

If you capture your own memories of the day, please do share them with us, we love to see all of your pictures. You can tag us on Twitter and Facebook and use the hashtag #ThanetColourRun.

Sponsorship

- £45 would pay for a one-to-one bereavement counselling session for someone struggling to cope with the loss of a loved one.

Useful Facts For The Day

- Wristband, tee shirt, glasses and colour sachet will be given out on the day.
- All the colour sachets used are bio-degradable and washes away with water.
- The paint is natural corn starch coloured with tested food and cosmetic dyes.
- The easiest way to get the powder off is while it's dry, shake your clothes and use a soft brush.
- If you have driven to the event and haven't brought a change of clothes, bring something to cover your car seat or seats on public transport.
- To avoid getting colour powders in your eyes, please wear the sunglasses provided.
- Please make sure you bring a bottle of water with you.
